## Town Board Proceedings

**November 17, 2021**

Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chippewa was called to order on November 17, 2021 @ 5:37pm. At roll call the following were present: Town Supervisors–Bill Ernst, John Bruch, Chairperson-Dan Koch, Clerk-Cindy Pritzl, Treasurer-Barb Koch, Town Employee–Roger Eder, Chuck Miesbauer and Eric Sitte.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve October 20, 2021, minutes. Motion carried.

Motion by Bruch, second by Ernst to approve payment of Checks (14769-14807) and Electronic Vouchers to WDOR & IRS (C2021103 – C20211107) Northern State Bank in the total of \$39,491.79.

### **Old Business:**

1. Discuss/Approve No Parking Ordinance for Lakeview Dr: Board would like to widen the shoulders where Bobber's on the Lake property is and put possibly two crosswalks on Lakeview Dr with lights to let drivers know to watch for pedestrians. This would be a project for next spring/summer.

1. Review/Approve Part-Time Snowplow Driver: The Town of Chippewa received 4 applications. Board reviewed all 4 of them and agreed to contact 3 of them and schedule interviews for December 1<sup>st</sup> starting interviews at 6:00pm and have the following every half and hours. Discuss/Approve Resident Snowplow Concern with Last Year: Resident had a complaint that last year their driveway was missed at least three times last year as it was an error on the town's end with not getting put on plow list. Resident feels that they should not have to pay full price this year for snowplowing. Board said that they should have been contacted right away after the first time they were missed for plowing. Board unanimously agreed to charge them full price this year. Clerk to contact resident.
