Town Board Proceedings

February 20, 2019

Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chippewa was called to order on February 20, 2019 @ 6:34pm. At roll call the following were present: Town Supervisors–Bill Ernst and Dan Koch, Chairperson–Bob Rybak, Clerk–Cindy Pritzl, Treasurer–Barb Koch and Town Employee–Charles Miesbauer, Roger Eder.

Motion by Ernst, second by Koch to approve Agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Koch, second by Ernst to approve minutes of Regular Mtg. on January 17. Motion carried.

Motion by Ernst, second by Koch to approve payment of Checks (13327-13383) and Electronic Vouchers to WDOR & IRS (C20190102 –C20190201), Northern State Bank in the total of \$329,762.24. Motion carried.

Old Business:

1. Approve Ad for Bids for Garbage/Recycling: Two bids were received. Waste Management Bid: 8yd trash \$230.00/month with a weekly pick up, 8yd recycling \$240.00/month with an every other week pick up. JB Disposal Bid: 8yd trash \$357.00/month with a weekly pick up, 8yd recycling \$110.00/month no date as how often he would pick up. Motion by Ernst, second by Koch to stay with Waste Management. Roll call vote: Ernst-yes, Koch-yes, Rybak-yes. Motion carried.
2. Options for Brushing in the Federal: Board is concerned that they won't be able to brush with the snowbanks. Road crew is more concerned with the limbs that are hanging over the road. Rybak will call J&J Brushing and see when they can come up and take a look at what we are dealing with. Main roads road crew is concerned about is 166 & 168. Both are approximately 2 miles for both.
