

Town of Chippewa: Minutes

Town Board Proceedings

March 17, 2021

Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chippewa was called to order on February 17, 2021 @ 6:30pm. At roll call the following were present: Town Supervisors–Bill Ernst and John Bruch, Chairperson-Dan Koch, Clerk-Cindy Pritzl, Treasurer–Barb Koch, Town Employee–Roger Eder, Chuck Miesbauer and Eric Sitte, Forward Bank Representative-Breann Eitrem.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve Agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Bruch, second by Ernst to approve minutes of Regular Mtg. on February 17, 2021. Motion carried.

Motion by Ernst second by Bruch to approve payment of Checks (14471-14507) and Electronic Vouchers to WDOR & IRS (C20210204 – C20210304) Northern State Bank in the total of \$21,919.41. Motion carried.

Old Business:

1. Discuss/Approve Prices for Crack Sealing: Price from Sherwin is \$0.52/lb, machine rental for a month is \$4,800.00, seal for the crack seal is \$63.68/5gal bucket. Motion by Bruch, second by Ernst to approve the purchase of 8 pallets of crack seal, 10 buckets of seal and machine rental for \$4,800.00. Motion carried. Rental will be split three ways with Chippewa, Village & Agenda.
2. Discuss/Approve Bidding out Asphalt Projects: Patches: Town Hall Rd 2 patches, Bear Lake Rd 3 patches. Black top 3/4 mile roughly about 45' past New Shanagolden Rd. Board would like to get a price for 2" or 2.5" blacktop. Board to get exact size and let clerk know.
3. Discuss Gating or Signing of Bruch Pit: County informed Clerk that it is the responsibility of the Town and County to put proper gating or signs up. Crew to get something set up and charge the County for half.

New Business:

1. Discuss/Approve Ad for Kids Chronical: There was an ad made from a 4th grader at Butternut School for the Town of Chippewa. For her ad to be put in the Kids Chronical we would need to purchase it for \$60.00 and then the Price County Review gives 20% back to the school. Motion by Koch, second by Ernst to approve the purchase of the ad for \$60.00. Motion carried.
2. Discuss Replacing Sterling: Board would like to investigate building a new box or possibly purchasing a new box for \$23,000 from Monroe. Board agreed to table until next month.
3. Discuss Ashland County Proposal of \$8.00 Fee for Septic on Tax Roll: Clerk explained that County is proposing a \$8.00 fee for anyone that has a septic that would be put on the tax roll. Board is not in favor of it.
