

# Town of Chippewa: Minutes

## Town Board Proceedings

April 19, 2022

Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chippewa was called to order on April 19, 2022 @ 6:05pm. At roll call the following were present: Town Supervisors–Bill Ernst, John Bruch, Chairperson-Dan Koch, Clerk-Cindy Pritzl, Treasurer-Barb Koch, Town Employee–Roger Eder, Eric Sitte, Chuck Miesbauer and Town Residents - Dave Meindl & Maxine Kilgar.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve Agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Bruch, second by Ernst to approve March 16, 2022, Regular Meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve payment of Checks (14993-15034) and Electronic Vouchers to WDOR & IRS (C20220304 – C20220404) Northern State Bank in the total of \$25,702.23.

### **Old Business:**

1. Discuss Follow Up on Federal Grant Program: Clerk hasn't heard anything regarding the program. Will put on the agenda if we need to.

### **New Business:**

1. Discuss/Approve Spring Clean Up Date: Board approved May 14, 2022, as the cleanup date from 8am – 2pm and prices will stay the same as last year.
2. Discuss/Approve Bidding Out Concrete for Pole Building: Board agreed to advertise for 7" concrete, foam w/rebar 60x80 commercial bag concrete. Board would like to open bids at next months meeting.
3. Discuss/Approve Resolution to Request that the State Legislature Modify Levy Limits: Board reviewed the letter from Vilas County and agreed that it was a good thing. Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to proceed with filing a resolution. Motion carried.
4. Discuss/Approve Bidding Out Black Top Project: Board would like to bid out the Weinberger Rd project from Lakeview to Stangle Rd (.5 miles) and the Bear Lake Project from New Shanagolden Rd for .5 miles. TRIP funds will be used for the Bear Lake Project.
5. Ashland County Sheriff's Report: None
6. Public Comment (Audience): Resident would like the road crew to brush back what they can on the local roads. Board said that as long as it's in the right of way and they talk to the landowner they will get the spots taken care of.
