

Town of Chippewa: Minutes

Town Board Proceedings

June 22, 2022

Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chippewa was called to order on June 22, 2022 @ 5:35pm. At roll call the following were present: Town Supervisors–Bill Ernst, John Bruch, Chairperson-Dan Koch, Clerk-Cindy Pritzl, Treasurer-Barb Koch, Town Employee–Roger Eder, Eric Sitte, Chuck Miesbauer, Kenny Pritzl, Town Residents - Dave Meindl.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve Agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Bruch, second by Ernst to approve May 18, 2022, Regular Meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve payment of Checks (15068-15103) and Electronic Vouchers to WDOR & IRS (C20220601– C20220604) Northern State Bank in the total of \$70,241.82.

Old Business:

1. Discuss Option for Gravel Pit: Board agreed to table until Bruch tells us to put it back on the agenda. Bruch will talk with the landowner. Bruch also mentioned that he is concerned that he didn't get his 500 yds of gravel. Board agreed to give him 380 yds out of what we just crushed.

New Business:

1. Discuss/Approve Liquor License: Bobbers on the Lake Class B Beer and Class B Liquor. Motion by Ernst, second by Bruch to approve Bobbers on the Lake Class B Beer and Liquor. Motion carried.
2. Discuss Parking Issue on Butternut Lake Rd: Officer Eder was called about a camper being parked right on the edge of the road. Their steps are on the road. Eder wanted the Town of Chippewa to know the concerns about parking and how narrow the road is with the camper parked right there. Ernst will talk with the owner of the camper.
3. Town of Draper Cooperative Agreement: Clerk received a letter from the Town of Draper stating that they are going to discontinue the agreement as of July 15, 2022. This means that we will revert to taking care of the 205 miles of Forest Road 326, 1.67 miles of Forest Road 172 and 0.46 miles of Old Grade Road.
4. Discuss Grader Issue: Eder informed board that the grader quit moving, code was flashing, now there are six codes. Transmission is due for a service. Sitte used it on Monday and the codes were still there. Board agreed to have the grader serviced.
5. Discuss/Approve Culvert Replacement on FR326: Ernst talked with Larry Palecek, he will do it. Larry will get a hold of Mark Koshak from the Forestry. Larry is booked until the end of July. He will give the town a price before he begins working on it. Board does not want the Town of Draper to help.
6. Ashland County Sheriff's Report: None
7. Public Comment (Audience): Sitte brought to the boards attention that there is an issue with the culverts. New house is being built on Bear Lake Rd and they did not get a driveway permit and they want a culvert. Clerk informed board it was 1 culvert for every 40 acres. Board agreed to investigate this and bring back for next months meeting.
